TRENDSETTER YARNS USED:

Bouquet #1522-9(11,13,15)/50gr. Trendsetter Needles #11

<u>SIZES</u>: Sm(32"), Med(35"), Lg(38"), XL(41"). Finished size is about 2" larger.

<u>GAUGE</u>: With #11 needle and Bouquet in Rev. Stock St.; 12sts = 4".

STITCHES USED:

<u>Rib St.:</u> Row 1: *K1,P1*. Rep *to* across. Row 2: Work stitches as set.

<u>Rev. Stock St.</u> Row 1: (RS) Purl across the row. Row 2: Knit across the row.

#3118 BOUQUET HANDKERCHIEF PULLOVER – Continued

FRONT & BACK: With #11 needle and Bouquet, Cast on 3sts with 3 separate skeins of yarn. Work in Rev. Stock St., Increasing 1 stitch each end of each piece every 4^{th} row 7(8,8,9)x. On the next row, join all stitches together onto one needle working across all pieces to join into one piece. Work back, Increasing 2(0,4,2)sts evenly across the next row. Continue in Rev. Stock St. on 53(57,61,65)sts until the body is 12(12 $\frac{1}{2}$,13,13)" from the joining. Bind off 3(3,3,3)sts at the beginning of the next 2 rows. Decrease 1 stitch each end every other row 4(4,4,4)x. Continue on 39(43,47,51)sts until armhole is 7(7 $\frac{1}{2}$,8,8 $\frac{1}{2}$)". Bind off 5(7,9,11)sts at the beginning of the next 2 rows. Place the remaining 29sts to a holder. Make another piece exactly the same.

SLEEVES: With #11 needle and Bouquet, Cast on 3sts with 2 separate skeins of yarn. Work in Rev. Stock St., Increasing 1 stitch each end of each piece every 4^{th} row 5(5,6,6)x. Work next row joining into one piece and continue on 26(26,30,30)sts in Rev. Stock St., Increasing 1 stitch each end every 6(6,7,6)rows 8(9,7,8)x. Continue on 42(44,44,46)sts until the sleeve is $14(14,14 \frac{1}{2},14 \frac{1}{2})^{"}$ from the joining. Bind off 3(3,3,3)sts at the beginning of the next 2 rows. Decrease 1 stitch each end every other row until the cap is $4(4 \frac{1}{2},5,5 \frac{1}{2})^{"}$. Bind off 2sts at the beginning of the next 4 rows. Bind off remaining stitches.

<u>FINISHING</u>: Sew the shoulder seams closed. Set the sleeves to the body by centering the cap to the shoulder seam and working down each side. Sew the remaining underarm and side seams closed. With #11 needle, Pick up stitches around the neck edge. Work around in one piece in Rib St. for 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ". Bind off in pattern.
