RAGLAN PULLOVER WITH ROLLED EDGES AND PATCH POCKET • Opera • Doppio
Size 34/36 (38/40, 42/44)

Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

Materials: 150 (200, 250) g of Lana Grossa **Opera** (65% cotton, 25% polyamide, 5% viscose, 5% sequins; 100 m/50 g) in Powder Pink (col 2) and 350 (400, 450) g of Lana Grossa **Doppio** (60% cotton, 40% polyamide; 130 m/50 g) in Rosé (col 105). Size 4.5 and

6 mm needles; size 4.5 mm circular needle, 60 cm long.

Stockinette: K on RS, p on WS.

Full-fashion decreases: At beg of RS row, k2tog, 3 sts in from edge; at end of RS row, SKP, 3 sts in from edge.

Gauges: 19 sts and 24 rows = 10 x 10 cm in stockinette with size 4.5 mm needles and Opera; 19 sts and 26 rows = 10 x 10 cm in stockinette with size 6 mm needles and Doppio.

Back: With size 4.5 mm needles and Opera, cast on 86 (94, 102) sts. Beg and end with a WS row, work in stockinette for 10 cm. Put work aside. With size 6 mm needles and Doppio, cast on 86 (94, 102) sts. Next WS row: Work in stockinette [= purl]. Next RS row: Holding this needle parallel and in front of size 4.5 mm needle [= sts with Opera], with size 6 mm needle, * ktog first st on front needle and first st on back needle; rep from * until all sts have been joined. Next, cont in stockinette with Doppio on size 6 mm needles until back measures 36 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape raglan: Working full-fashion decreases, dec 1 st at beg and end of next 25 (29, 33) RS rows. Bind off remaining 36 sts.

Front: Work same as for back until raglan measures 15 (18, 21) cm, ending with a WS row. Shape neck: Bind off center 14 sts. Working each side separately, bind off 3 sts at each neck edge once, 2 sts once and 1 st twice and when front measures same length as back to shoulders and all raglan decreases have been worked, bind off remaining 4 sts for each shoulder.

Sleeves: With size 4.5 mm needles and

Opera, cast on 40 (44, 48) sts. Beg and end with a WS row, work in stockinette for 13 cm. Put work aside. With size 6 mm needles and Doppio, cast on 40 (44, 48) sts. Next WS row: Work in stockinette [= purl]. Next RS row: Holding this needle parallel and in front of size 4.5 mm needle [= sts with Opera], with size 6 mm needle, * ktog first st on front needle and first st on back needle; rep from * until all sts have been joined. Next, cont in stockinette with Doppio on size 6 mm needles and shape sleeve as foll: Inc 1 st at beg and end of every 6th row 10 (7, 3) times, then every foll 4th row 3 (8, 14) times = 66 (74, 82) sts. Cont in stockinette until sleeve measures 43 cm from

cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape raglan same as for back raglan. Bind off remaining 16 sts.

Pocket: With size 4.5 mm needles and Opera, cast on 21 sts and work in stockinette for 10.5 cm. Bind off all sts on next RS row.

Finishing: Pin pieces to measurements and block. Sew pocket to front according to schematic. Sew raglan seams. With size 4.5 mm circular needle and Opera, pick up and knit 106 sts around neck edge. Join for working in the rnd, knit 3 rnds, then bind off all sts loosely. Sew side and sleeve seams.
