TRENDSETTER YARNS USED:

*Marrakech #433-9(11,13,15)/50gr.

*Joy #1554-8(10,12,14)/25gr.

*1 strand each together = MC.

Trendsetter Needles #13

SIZES: Sm(33"), Med(36"), Lg(39"), Xl(42").

Finished size is about 3" larger.

STITCHES USED:

Rev. Stock St.:

Row 1: (RS) Purl across the row.

Row 2: Knit across the row.

GAUGE: With #13 needle and MC in

Rev. Stock St.; 10sts = 4".

BACK: With #13 needle and Segue, Cast on 44(48,52,56)sts. Change to MC and work in Rev. Stock St. until $12(12 \frac{1}{2},13,13)$ " from the cast on. Bind off 3(3,4,4)sts at the beginning of the next 2 rows. Decrease 1 stitch each end every other row 3(4,4,5)x. Continue on 32(34,36,38)sts until the armhole is $7(7 \frac{1}{2},8,8 \frac{1}{2})$ ". Bind off.

FRONTS: With #13 needle and Segue, Cast on 22(24,26,28)sts. Change to MC and work in Rev. Stock St. until 7" from the cast on. Mark the neck edge. Decrease 1 stitch at the neck edge on the next row and then every 4^{th} row 7x more. **AT THE SAME TIME:** When $12(12 \frac{1}{2},13,13)$ " from the cast on, Bind off 3(3,4,4)sts at the armside edge 1x. Decrease 1 stitch at the armside edge every other row 3(4,4,5)x. Continue on remaining stitches until the armhole is $7(7 \frac{1}{2},8,8 \frac{1}{2})$ " and all neck shaping is done. Bind off remaining stitches.

SLEEVES: With #13 needle and Segue, Cast on 18(18,20,20)sts. Change to MC and work in Rev. Stock St, Increasing 1 stitch each end every 6(5,6,5)rows 8(9,8,9)x. Continue on 34(36,36,38)sts until the sleeve is $17(17,17 \frac{1}{2},17 \frac{1}{2})$ ". Bind off 3(3,4,4)sts at the beginning of the next 2 rows. Decrease 1 stitch each end every other row until the cap is $5(5 \frac{1}{2},6,6 \frac{1}{2})$ ". Bind off 2sts at the beginning of the next 2 rows. Bind off.

FINISHING: Sew the shoulder seams closed. Set the sleeves to the body by centering the cap to the shoulder seam and working down each side. Sew the remaining underarm and side seams closed. With #G crochet hook and Segue, work 1 row of Single Crochet around the neck edge. Work 1 row of Rev. Single Crochet around the complete front and bottom edge. Work 1 row of Rev. Single Crochet around the sleeve cuff to finish off.
