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TRENDSETTER YARNS USED:

Smoothies – 1/200gr. cake ball
Needles #7.

SIZE: One Size Fits all

GAUGE: With #7 needle and Smoothies in
Garter St.; 16sts=4". Adjust needle to get gauge.

STITCHES USED:

Garter St.:
KNIT every row.

#5501-F TRANSITIONS SMOOTHIES DIAGONAL GARTER ST. SAIL SHAWL – KNITTING INSTRUCTIONS

NOTES: This shawl is knit starting at one side edge and colors will transition on their own. Decreases are worked at one edge to create a long to edge and increases are worked inside of the work along the opposite edge to slow down the shape and create a piece that looks like a ships sail. Because everyone knits to a different row gauge, some knitters will have extra yarn, some will run out and some will just make it.

SHAWL: With #7 needle and Smoothies, Cast on 200sts. Knit 1 row as follows:

4sts border, Place marker. 196sts body.

Change to work as follows:

Row 1: (RS) K1, SSK. Knit until 1 stitch before marker. Work knit Front/Back increase on next stitch. Move marker. K4sts border.

Row 2: Knit until 3sts before the end K2-tog,K1.

Repeat 2 row pattern until all stitches are gone or enough yarn remains to bind off. The design is set to work angular like a sail. Fasten off.

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
